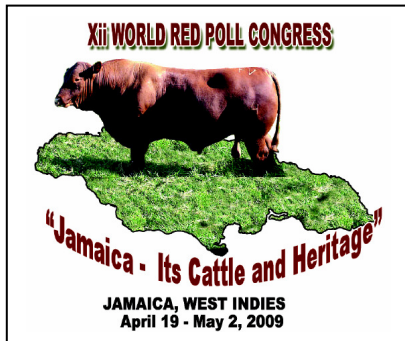

Terms and Conditions

1. **Reservations:** Can be made in writing either by email or facsimile using the Registration Form.
2. **Payment/Plan:** A non-Refundable payment of US\$1000 must be made with submission of Registration Form by September 30, 2008. Final payment is due by January 31, 2009
3. **Payment:** Must be made in US Currency by Telegraphic Transfer to credit our designated Bank Account below.

4. **Cancellation:** Refunds on full payment will be made less the US \$1000.00 registration fee for cancellations received in writing before February 14, 2009. No refunds will be made after February 15, 2009
5. All local taxes associated with the tour are included in the registration fee but do not include bank charges, International or Domestic airfares, airport departure taxes or any insurance
6. All rates are quoted in US\$ (dollars), all currency conversions are the responsibility of the participant
7. Arrival and Departure details must be advised to the Congress organizers before February 15, 2009.
8. **Insurance:** Participants are advised that during the tour they may be subject to various risks or dangers. We strongly recommend that you insure yourself fully against cancellations, loss of luggage damage or loss of personal property and medical expenses as neither the Jamaica Red Poll Cattle Breeders Society nor the International Red Poll Cattle Breeders Organising Committee will accept liability for any losses, damage, theft or medical expenses of any kind. Your travel agent should be able to provide you with further information and appropriate insurance.
9. **Visa/Passports:** You will require a valid passport. You are responsible for arranging your own passport, visas and health requirements (including inoculation, if required). You should check with your travel agent who will be able to provide you with necessary information.
10. **Local Claims:** Any disputes under or in connection with this agreement or tour shall be governed and construed in accordance with the laws of Jamaica. The Courts of Jamaica shall have sole and exclusive jurisdiction to hear and determine all disputes in connection with this agreement or tour.
11. **No commission** is payable to any party including travel agents, societies, or tour wholesalers.
